To provide a fast, free, and frequent transportation alternative for residents and visitors, the City of Orlando partnered with the Central Florida Regional Transportation Authority (LYNX) to expand the LYMMO Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) system that serves the greater downtown area.

As a member of a design-build team, Tindale Oliver provided urban design, landscape architecture, public outreach, and environmental graphics services for this project. We assisted with the planning, design, and implementation of the transit system's routes, stations, stops, landscape, hardscape, irrigation, and passenger amenities including information kiosk graphics, transit maps, benches, bicycle racks, trash receptacles, and bus vehicle graphics for the system's operational fleet.

Tindale Oliver coordinated public outreach activities for the project, including media relations and public events such as meetings, open houses, and workshops, and conducted stakeholder interviews and surveys. Also provided were graphic design and technical support services for public outreach tools, including maintaining the project website (www.golymmo.com), producing and distributing mailings and newsletters, making presentations, and developing displays and visualization graphics to inform and build consensus.
